

A One Act Children's Nativity Play

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A SHEPHERD'S CHILDHOOD MEMORY

STAGING:

- STAGE CENTER: Stable with a manger can be simple or include hay, animals (even 2 dimensional). You may want a light on the back to help light the angels.
- STAGE REAR: Risers Hopefully the stable can be in front of the risers to hide your angels, then they can move to the top row when they need to do their part
- STAGE RIGHT: Shepherd's field a few bales of hay with a makeshift fire in the middle
- STAGE RIGHT: Fake wall with door. Above the door is a sign "Bethlehem Inn" Perhaps "NO VACANCY" on the sign somewhere as if it's added.
- SCREEN: *(optional)* If power point or other multimedia is available, there are a suggestions to add to the production
- LIGHTS: *(optional)* one or two spots fixed on the aisle or aisles – flood lights - one to illuminate the manger and another to light up the angels

- CHARACTERS: 1 Adult and 7-9 children's speaking parts unlimited extras
- LEVI The only adult in the production. A 40 something shepherd
- AARON One of three 8-12 year old shepherds about 6 lines
- ISAIAH One of three 8-12 year old shepherds about 5 lines
- ELI (optional you can have just 2 shepherds) One of three 8-12 year old shepherds – about 4 lines – If you opt to have no Eli, give his lines to another shepherd and omit his name in dialogue.
- JOSEPH Mary's husband about 7 lines
- MARY Jesus' Mother 3 lines
- INNKEEPER(S) Boy or Girl 6 lines (Optionally written for 2 children – combine INNKEEPER 1 & INNKEEPER 2 if you're only using one innkeeper) (Optional: INNKEEPER(S) may also be in the Choir of Angels)
- ANGEL Any boy or girl 2 lines
- CHOIR OF ANGELS the rest of your younger girls (could be boys) 1 line repeated all together
- SHEPHERDS the rest of your younger boys (or girls) no lines, but some pantomime to go along with the narration
- WISE MEN (optional) if you have a lot of extra kids, several of them can be wise men/women – there is an optional part to Scene V for them. CAN BE MORE OR LESS THAN THREE!!! We don't know how many wise men there were, only that there were 3 gifts. (If you have a very small cast, the shepherds can also be Wise Men)

SCENE I

1	SCREEN: starry night
2	LIGHTS: spot on Shepherd's Field
3	LEVI: (entering from the audience aisle speaking with
4	excitement to the younger shepherds) Aaron, Eli,
5	Isaiah, come here. I have news.
6	AARON: (entering stage left with Isaiah and Eli) What kind
7	of news, Levi? Did something happen while you were
8	in Bethlehem today?
9	All shepherds sit on bales of hay near the "fire"
10	LEVI: Nothing happened, but I overheard the townspeople
11	talking about some excitement that happened in
12	Jerusalem last spring.
13	ISAIAH: Excitement in Jerusalem? What happened in
14	Jerusalem that would make any difference to shepherds
15	in Bethlehem?
16	LEVI: To be perfectly honest, I'd heard some rumors the
17	last couple of times I went into town, but I didn't think
18	it could be true. (Beginning to digress into his own
19	little world) I mean even if everything I'd heard was
20	true, the chances of it being (his thoughts begin to
21	sound random) It was just a baby, who'd have thought
22	
23	ISAIAH, ELI and AARON: (look at each other and shrug)

- LEVI: (continuing) It's been . . . wow . . . how long . . .
 (thinking and completely forgetting there is anyone
 else around) . . . must have been . . . let's see . . .
 Quirinius was governor . . . so . . .
- 5 ELI (or AARON): (*clears his throat*) Levi, what ARE you
 6 talking about?
- 7 **ISAIAH**: Yeah, you aren't making any sense.

8 LEVI: (kind of waking up) What? Oh! Sorry! Let's see ...
9 before I tell you the exciting news I heard today, I
10 guess I better start at the beginning so you'll see why
11 it's so amazing. Like I said Quirinius was governor
12 and (digressing again ... thoughts keep wandering) ...

- 13 . let's see . . . Augustus was Caesar, so it must have
 14 been more than 30 years ago. I wasn't much more than
 15 your age when it happened.
- 16 AARON: (beginning to get frustrated) When WHAT17 happened?
- 18 LEVI: I keep doing that. It's just all so amazing! And it
 19 was so long ago, I haven't thought about it in a long
 20 time . . .

SCENE II

LEVI: Let's see . . . When I was about your age, the most 1 amazing thing I'd ever seen happened. 2 Caesar 3 Augustus decided he wanted a head count of everyone who lived in Roman territory. To get everyone 4 5 counted, every family in the country had to return to their ancestral home. I remember the older shepherds 6 7 didn't even try to go into town for weeks. It was so 8 crowded in Bethlehem.

9 *LIGHTS*: Dim spot comes up on Mary and Joseph as they
10 enter from audience on the opposite side of Levi

11 LEVI: (*continues*) Families came from all over to be
12 counted. I didn't realize there were so many
13 descendants of King David. People were sleeping
14 everywhere.

LIGHTS: fade on shepherds and come up full on Joseph and
Mary and follow them to the inn.

17 JOSEPH: Are you all right, Mary? We're almost there.18 Look at the crowds! I hope we can find a room.

19 MARY: I'll be fine, but we really need to find a place soon.

20 Mary & Joseph stop at the Inn

- 21 **JOSEPH**: Let's check this place. (Knocks on the door)
- 22 **INNKEEPER 1**: (Opens the door) Hello, may I help you?
- 23 **JOSEPH**: We're looking for a room.
- 24 **INNKEEPER 2**: I'm sorry, but we're all filled up.

- MARY: But I'm going to have a baby soon. Maybe tonight! 1 **INNKEEPER 1**: (still very professional) We really don't 2 have any space available. 3 JOSEPH: We don't need anything fancy, but we need to 4 5 find someplace BEFORE she has this baby. 6 **INNKEEPER 2**: (a little annoyed) Look, everything is full. 7 Even the stable only has one stall left. 8 JOSEPH & MARY · We'll take it **INNKEEPER 2**: (very agitated) What do you mean you'll 9 10 take it? I didn't mean you could stay there, I was just hoping you'd get the hint and move on. 11 12 JOSEPH: My wife can't move on. She's going to have a baby anytime now. Can't we have the open stall? 13 **INNKEEPER 1**: (exasperated) Oh, all right! Go ahead and 14 sleep in the stable, but no complaining about the smell 15 16 or the noise. starts closing the door and mumbles from *behind the door* – Some people! I can't believe they're 17 staying in the barn 18 Mary and Joseph move on to the stable as the light fades on 19
- 20 *them and comes up on the shepherds*

SCENE III

1	LEVI: I felt so bad for that family. They only came to
2	Bethlehem because of the census. They were so far
3	from home, and then had a baby right there with all the
4	animals. I still remember Joseph telling us that story,
5	but he didn't seem to mind. You should have seen him!
6	He was so surprised when we found them. What a
7	night that was!
8	ELI (or AARON): So, was it your cousin or something?
9	LEVI: On no. No relation. I'd never even met Joseph before,
10	and I never saw him again.
11	ISAIAH: Then why did you go see his new baby?
12	LEVI: That's the truly amazing part of the story! We'd
13	been out in the fields with the sheep for months. Like I
14	said, town was crazy with people, so no one went in
15	from the fields unless they had to. It was really late,
16	we'd put out all the torches and only the fire was left
17	burning. The night was quiet. It was so peaceful. The
18	sky was clear and full of stars, a lot like tonight. In fact
19	most of us were asleep. I think Grandfather was the
20	only one left awake. And that's when it all started!
21	Grandfather said that the sky began to get very bright
22	SCREEN: brightens gradually until it's very bright when
23	the angel appears

- LEVI: (continuing) By the time I woke up it was brighter
 than day, but only in the one spot in the sky. Yep, it
 was right over there (pointing toward where the angels
 will appear and sounding even more excited) I'll never
 forget it! It's the most amazing thing I've ever seen in
 my life!
- 7 **AARON**: *(catching the excitement)* What? What was it!!???
- 8 **ANGEL**: (moves into position)
- 9 *LIGHTS*: spotlight begins to come up on the angel and fade
 10 on the shepherds
- LEVI: An angel. It was a real live angel . . . *(laughing)* and
 we were absolutely terrified.
- 13 *LIGHTS*: full on angel, faded on shepherds
- ANGEL: Don't be afraid. I'm here to bring you good news
 of great joy that will be for all people. Today in the
 city of David a baby has been born, and He is Christ
 the Lord. And this is how you'll find Him: You'll find
 a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.
- 19 *LIGHTS*: Up on stable as Mary lays the baby in the manger
- 20 LEVI: (no light on him, his voice speaks in hushed tones)
 21 We were all stunned. No one said a word and then:
 22 (lights up on all angels)
- 23

- ANGEL CHOIR: (stands on either side of the lead angel
 and repeats together) Glory to God in the highest and
 peace to men on earth! Glory to God in the highest and
 peace to men on earth!
- 5 Cast sings first verse of "Angels We Have Heard On High"
- 6 LIGHTS: fade on angels and stable and back up on
 7 shepherds
- 8 SCREEN: goes back to starry night

SCENE IV

AARON: You've got to be kidding! ANGELS!!! You saw 1 2 real Angels?!!! 3 **LEVI**: Yep! Real angels. For a minute or so everyone was completely silent. We each thought we were the only 4 5 ones who saw it, but finally someone asked, "Did you see that?" Then everyone began talking all at once. 6 7 We knew we had to go into town immediately. At first 8 we didn't know who to leave with the sheep, but it 9 didn't take long to decide we'd take our chances and 10 leave them here by themselves. No one wanted to miss 11 out. **ISAIAH**: You left the sheep alone?!!! NO WAY!! 12 LEVI: I know it's hard to believe, but this was THAT 13 14 important! LEVI: (excited) I don't think I've ever walked to Bethlehem 15 that fast before. We wondered what kind of baby this 16 17 was to have an entire of army of angels announce his birth. We couldn't stop talking all the way there 18 **SHEPHERDS**: Enter from rear audience opposite LEVI. 19 LIGHTS: fade on shepherds in field and come up on 20 21 shepherds hurrying toward stable – Levi's voice is still 22 *heard telling about their trip* LEVI: Then we saw the stable. 23 ELI (or ISAIAH): A stable? The Baby was in a Stable? 24

1	LEVI: Oh yes. Remember? The angel said we'd find the
2	baby in a manger. (Levi begins talking with mystery in
3	his voice) Anyway, it was late and there was only one
4	building that still had a lamp lit.
5	SHEPHERDS : <i>STOP</i> – <i>look and point</i> – <i>continue to gesture</i>
6	as Levi talks
7	LEVI: We wondered if we should all go in or just one of us
8	go first. We really didn't know what to do. I was so
9	excited to see this baby, I could hardly breathe.
10	SHEPHERDS: whispering to one another, looking
11	confused, etc
12	LEVI: Finally, one of us got the courage to slowly walk
13	over to the stable.
14	SHEPHERDS: one shepherd walks over to the stable –
15	JOSEPH motions for him to come in, and this shepherd
16	motions for the others to follow him as LEVI continues
17	and shepherds enter
18	LEVI: A man motioned for us to come in. When we entered
19	the stable, we immediately knelt in front of the manger
20	SHEPHERDS: kneel on either side of the manger, so the
21	audience can still see the manger
22	LEVI: It was almost as if we couldn't stand anymore. The
23	minute we walked in we could feel the peace and the
24	magnificence of this baby. I'd never been part of
25	anything so important in my life. I kept wondering why

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God picked us to tell about the baby. I figured Kings 1 and governors would be showing up any minute. 2 (pausing for a moment – growing quieter and even 3 4 *more reverent* – *shepherds still bowing*) We just stayed 5 there bowing for quite some time. This was definitely 6 a different baby. (very still for a moment) Finally, we 7 got up from our knees (pausing while the miming 8 *shepherds rise*) 9 **SHEPHERDS**: *rise very slowly, one at a time* 10 **JOSEPH:** *stands and shakes hands with shepherds – make it* a good strong hand shake – look like Joseph is 11 12 speaking to the shepherds LEVI: We shook Joseph's hand and he told us a bit of their 13 story about how they came from Nazareth. 14 15 **LEVI**: (pauses thoughtfully for a moment to allow shepherds 16 to speak with Joseph – Then very softly, but passionately – staring at the fire) When we left, we 17 walked much slower back to the shepherd's field. We 18 didn't even talk, we were so in awe of what we'd just 19 20 seen. **SHEPHERDS**: walk back in awe toward the rear of the 21

23 LIGHTS: fade on miming shepherds and back up on
24 shepherd's field.

SCENE V

1	LEVI: That day was the most amazing in my whole life.
2	I've never forgotten that night. And I've always
3	wondered what happened to that family. There was a
4	bit of a stir some time after the baby was born.
5	KINGS: (optional) enter from rear audience opposite Levi
6	LIGHTS: (only if wise men are used) up on Kings – fade on
7	shepherds
8	LEVI: We heard some rich guys from the east came in to
9	town following this strange star, looking for a child.
10	SCREEN: bring large star into the starry night
11	KINGS: (optional) move to where Mary and Joseph are as a
12	portion of "We Three Kings" play or kids can sing one
13	or two verses – recommended: Go Fish Guys version –
14	toward the end of the second chorus the Kings move
15	back toward rear where they entered
16	LEVI : (if song is used, this is following the song – If there's
17	no song, Levi should just continue) They called him
18	"King of the Jews." The older shepherds were sure it
19	was the same baby we'd seen that night. (growing
20	contemplative) But until today, I've never heard
21	another word about that family. (Levi stops talking -
22	there are a few seconds where everyone is quiet)
23	SCREEN: Fade star to starry night

SCENE VI

1	AARON : (waiting a moment or two – then impatiently
2	breaking the silence) But Levi, what happened today?
3	What's today got to do with a baby you saw when you
4	were a kid?
5	LEVI: Oh yes! (getting excited again) That IS how this
6	story started, isn't it? During the last three years, I've
7	heard rumors of this teacher with a kind of a rag tag
8	following. According to everything I've heard, he's
9	done some pretty remarkable things. They're saying
10	he's healed people, fed huge crowds with just a bit of
11	food and even walked on water. I guess last spring the
12	rulers in Jerusalem didn't like it that he was getting so
13	many followers, because they killed him on a cross.
14	SCREEN: fades to silhouette or shadow of a cross or three
15	crosses
16	ISAIAH: I've heard some of those stories, but I still don't
17	understand what they have to do with that baby?
18	LEVI: Well, I never thought too much about those rumors,
19	but they are saying this guy's followers call him Jesus
20	of Nazareth, and three days after he was crucified, they
21	went to his grave and he was gone.
22	SCREEN: fades to an empty grave
23	ELI (or AARON): What do you mean, "gone"? Someone stole
24	his body? How gross is that?

- LEVI: There are some people who think the body was 1 stolen, but what's really causing a stir all over Judah is 2 the people are saying He's alive. People have seen Him 3 4 . . . and I'm pretty sure *(pausing, digressing*) 5 *reflectively staring at the fire*) . . . it's really amazing . . 6 *Quiet* for a moment 7 **SCREEN**: fades back to a starry night 8 LEVI: His followers said they saw Him being lifted to 9 10 heaven. And they said his name was Jesus of Nazareth ... Jesus ... the same name as the baby. The baby 11 12 that angels said would be "Christ the Lord." Our people have been waiting for more than 2000 years for 13 the Messiah to appear. 14 15 **LEVI**: (It's all sinking in now and he begins to sound angry 16 with himself-Maybe even stands up and begins walking around a bit) Why didn't I pay more attention to those 17 angels?! They told us this was the Christ, the Messiah. 18 And after we saw the baby, even though we knew 19 20 when we saw him that there was something different, 21 something awe inspiring about this infant, it still didn't 22 sink in that this was more than just a baby. 23 LEVI: (tone changing to awe) I SAW the Messiah . . . I stood in the presence of the Chosen One of God . . . I 24
- 25 was one of the first to kneel and worship Him. WOW!

1	Who would have imagined that the One God sent to be
2	the Savior of the World would come as a baby? And
3	will anyone ever believe God told shepherds first?
4	AARON: So, you really think this baby was the Savior of
5	the World?
6	LEVI: (with passion) I do I REALLY DO!!! I'm not
7	exactly sure how it works, but I tell you something.
8	I'm not going to spend anymore time in this field until
9	I do. (exits toward rear of audience)
10	ELI (or ISAIAH): (calling out after Levi) But what about the
11	sheep?
12	LEVI: (yelling back) You guys keep an eye on them. When
13	I figure out exactly how this baby is going to save the
14	world, I'll be back to let you know. I wasted all these
15	years not paying attention to those angels. I'm not
16	going to waste anymore.
17	LIGHTS : fade on LEVI and up on manger – end with last
